FIREFLY – 13 March 2020 – FIREFLY Closures – Effective March 16th to April 5th inclusive

As a result of preventative measures with the COVID-19 virus resulting in school closures, FIREFLY offices in the following spaces will be closed effective Monday, March 16th to Sunday, April 5th, inclusive.

The following sites are affected:

- Sioux Lookout FIREFLY Office located at Sioux North High School
- Red Lake FIREFLY Office located at Red Lake-Madsen Public School

In addition, our FIREFLY EarlyON locations will be closed for the same time period:

- Sioux Lookout EarlyON Centre located at Sioux Mountain Public School
- Kenora EarlyON Centre located in the Kenora Public Library
- Minto EarlyON Centre located at 26-1181 Minto Ave. in Kenora. This location will have reduced programming. FIREFLY will be working on a plan for continuing programs for provision of food.
